

Classification Protest Form

Scope of Protests

A 'Protest' is a challenge filed against the Sport Class allocated to a Player.

Parties permitted to make a Protest

A Protest may only be made by: (i) a National Federation; or (ii) the IGF.

National Federation Protest

A National Federation Protest may be made where there is a reasonable basis to believe that the Player may have been allocated an incorrect Sport Class. Protests may be filed with the use of this form through the prescribed IGF Classification Rule 40.7

For a protest to be considered for a tournament, the protest must be submitted to the IGF Head of Classification:

- Prior to the commencement of a Covered Competition in which the player is to make their first appearance within 48 hours of the publication,
or
- Where the protested decision is published during the Covered Competition in which the player makes their first appearance, within one hour of the publication.
- A Protest fee of 200 Euro (Invoiced by the IGF).

IGF Protest

The IGF may make an IGF Protest where it considers that the Player may have been allocated an incorrect Sport Class.

When an NF/NPC suspects that an athlete outside their jurisdiction has been assigned an incorrect sport class, they can request the IGF to conduct a review with the intention of initiating an IGF Protest.
