This short course on Safeguarding Essentials is designed to support everyone involved in sport whether you are in a voluntary or paid role either for an international sports organisation, for a national sport association, for a sports club, or as an athlete or player, a coach, manager, official or other role, such as a safeguarding or child protection lead, physiotherapst or medio.

The course is designed for everyone from grassroots to the elite. It is divided into three 30-minute sessions for you to complete at your own pace. The course explains how safeguarding is everybody's responsibility.

This course is free and open to all, and you are welcome to study it without enrolling. However, if you want to earn an Open University digital badge for your learning, you'll need to enrol on the course.
